- **Back 2 School Store**, where hundreds of local, economically disadvantaged children can “shop” for brand-new clothes and school supplies in a one- day-only store set up just for them.
- **The Volunteer Network**, which each year matches hundreds of teen and adult volunteers with volunteer opportunities in local nonprofit agencies.
- **The Linda & Rudy Slucker NCJW Center for Women** (CFW), where we provide numerous free and low-cost services, including a teen dating abuse prevention program, support groups for women and children, a workshop/speaker series, computer classes, legal help for women, and job-readiness counseling. In addition, as part of the statewide Displaced Homemaker Network, CFW provides back-to-work assistance – including resume and interview help, computer skills classes, and even a work-appropriate starter wardrobe – for women who unexpectedly must re-enter the workforce.
